



Flower Morphology

Grade Level: K

Time: 30 minutes

Materials: Lily flowers, crayons, *Flower Model Plus & Flower Power* worksheet.

Activity

Model

Assemble : *Flower, Model Plus*. Show kids each component of the model and describe its specific function. Detailed descriptions are located within the *Model Plus Flower Teachers Note* pamphlet found inside the box.

Activity

- Split class into groups of 5.
- Pass out a lily flower to each group purchased at Atkinson's. This flower has easily identifiable parts.
- Pass out the labeled “Flower Power” Worksheet.
- Have children as a class identify the 4 flower parts highlighted on the worksheet by using their live lily.
- Have children color the worksheet. Explain that the 4 flower parts must be colored differently.

Split the class into groups:

- Each group should make up physical movements for each flower part.
- Share each groups movement with the entire class!

Conclusion

Children should be able to identify 4 major flower parts.

As an extension teach the unit on Pollination. The students will then be able to connect the form (flower parts) with a flower function (pollination).
